The meeting started with short <u>self-introductions</u> including scientific background, ErUM community, and mandates in DIG-UM/ErUM-Data.

PRISMA Forum / ErUM-Data-Hub

Information on the ErUM-Data-Hub was presented to the PRISMA Forum by Mr. Lilienthal on 30.8.22. Mrs Petersen reported that he thanked for the input of the Forum on 8.3.22 and mentioned that recommendations of the forum were taken up [referencing 1) joint planned event with NFDI—see below -, and 2) starting at an early stage of education with already PhD and Master students at our summer school. The graphic with the different participations from different ErUM communities was also explicitly highlighted and well received.] The BMBF presented the ErUM-Data-Hub very positively and emphasized the important role in data science education.

Common Workshop with NFDI

The common workshop ErUM-Data and NFDI will be in person at the meeting facilities of the Frankfurt Airport 11:00-16:00 on 24-Oct-2022 (planned to be not hybrid). The room has been booked for 30 (up to 50) participants, a catering will be organized. An indico page for the agenda and registration will be prepared by DESY people. The program is being worked out by Astrid Schneidewind, Monica Valencia-Schneider, Kilian Schwarz, Thomas Schörner-Sardenius. The agenda includes presentations on the actual progress in both structures and sufficient time for strategy-forming discussions.

Annual Meeting of the ErUM-Communities

The annual meeting will take place in week 50 as a purely virtual meeting. An exact date is still to be announced by the overview board.
