Discussion on the target group of workshops and schools

According to the funding application of the ErUM Data Hub, we aim at networking - further education - transfer of the ErUM communities to accelerate scientific progress in ErUM.

- Admission to workshops and schools is open to all national and international students and scientist working in the research field of ErUM at a German institution with a matriculation or working contract.
- Other participants are not automatically eligible, but may be admitted on individual basis. A reason can be that they are associated as a guest scientist to an above-mentioned German institutions and actively contribute to ErUM research. Participants without a direct relation to ErUM research at a German institution may be admitted in exceptional cases.
- Independently, we will invite speakers from over the world to give presentations for the purpose of the workshops and schools.

Topic Groups

Elections: in September, the Topic Group Chairs will contact/email their groups to initiate the discussion of the elections for topic group chairs and deputies for the 2 years starting 12/2022.

Federated Infrastructure
