### **Short reports from the Topic Groups**

#### **Federated Infrastructure**

Markus: The white paper on the ErUM community requirements in federated infrastructures is being continuously worked on, recently KFN has been included. The white paper should be finished in summer 22.

#### **Big Data Analytics**

Gregor:

- The review of the BMBF call on “software and algorithms” is delayed, so that the funding can only start in March 23. When asked by the Big Data Analytics management, only 2-3 of the applying groups responded with usual comments, but from which no need for an official statement arises.
- In the survey about the needs in Big Data Analytics, 41 people have already participated! a detailed analysis will be provided soon.
- The University of Hamburg has access to a tool for surveys that is available to its members. Should the ErUM Data Hub have more frequent needs, an associated account could be initiated.

#### **Research Data Management**

Monica, Astrid:

- The preparations for the BMBF Call Research Data Management (originally planned for summer 23) will start soon. A strategy meeting with the BMBF department will certainly not take place in Sept. 22 (Simon Bohleber on email).
- For coordination with the NFDI, a joint workshop day NFDI & ErUM-Data is planned, conversations on this with Thomas Schörner-Sardenius have also started.

#### **User Interface**

Pierre Tim: The strategy group has met and formulated various attractive titles for a workshop. Once the title is fixed, a workshop layout will drive the further planning and corresponding invitations.

#### **Knowledge Distribution**

- The second Train-the-Trainer Workshop on “Deep Learning Advanced” concepts in Wuppertal went extremely well. The survey by the participants will be evaluated soon.
