- Federated Infrastructures (Markus):
 - The document on the needs of the different communities will be open access on <u>www.erumdatahub.de</u> very soon, will be published in the Journal on Computing and Software in Big Science.
- Big Data Analytics (Thomas, Jan):
 - The first meeting of the topic group with new chairs will be this afternoon.
 - The Train-the-Trainer workshop 7./8.2. in Garching needs registrations, we'll all use our personal connections to encourage participations. The dhep-mailing list will be also used.
 - After that the next big event is the BDA connection workshop in Hamburg 23./24.2.
 Information about the workshop has been distributed by PT.DESY to all funded ErUM-Data projects and the speakers of all initial project-sketches with in total 130 addresses.

- Research Data Management (Astrid, Monica):
